

## To Applicants for the Graduate School of Economics and Management:

The applicants for the Graduate School of Economics and Management need to prepare not only the required documents for DSP II but also the following additional required documents, then please submit them to the DSP II Admission office.

### **Required documents:**

- Required documents for DSP II

\*Applicants for the Graduate School of Economics and Management cannot use TOEIC® Test score report

\*Applicant's score should be 79 higher for a TOEFL iBT® Test (for TOEFL®PBT Test, 550 or higher) or 6 or higher for an IELTS (Academic)

If submitting a TOEFL® Test score, please request the ETS to send the Institutional Score Report for your test, which must have been taken on or after March 1, 2018, to us. Our Institution Code is 0232. We only accept TOEFL iBT® scores from a single test date, NOT MyBest™ scores. If submitting an IELTS score, please submit your original form or copy of the IELTS Test Report Form (official certificate) dated on or after March 1, 2018.

### **Additional required documents for Graduate School of Economics and Management**

- General Test score for the Graduate Record Examination (GRE®) or Official Score Report –Test Taker Copy for the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT®)

If submitting a GRE® Test score, please have ETS send the Graduation Institution Score Report for your test, which must have been taken on or after March 1, 2015, to the graduate school of Economics and Management. The DI Code is 4137. If submitting a GMAT® score, please submit the GMAT® Official Score Report or copy along with the other required documents, for your test, dated on or after March 1, 2015.
