GSIS Building (Completed in March 2001) 情報科学研究科研究実験棟 (2001.3竣工)



 8 stories with floor space of 8,133㎡ (8階建8,133㎡)

The Touzai-line of the Sendai City Subway opened about five years ago.

②21 divisions (mainly math, biology, human and social sciences) out of 38 are housed in this main building.

Commute by subway is recommended. 通学はなるべく地下鉄で

Because of the opening of the subway, and because of the shortage in the space of parking, commute by car is essentially limited to office workers, professors, and students in the doctoral course who live more than 2km away from the campus.

If you are a doctoral course student and want to come to the Aobayama campus by your own car, you have to pay 500 yen per month for the parking fee. Regular Inspection by an industrial doctor and a safety administrator: Each office is required to promptly correct problems pointed out, such as complex wiring and obstructed doorways.

The Evacuation Drill is scheduled in the fall every year.

Smoking is completely prohibited in all the campuses in Tohoku University.

Sidewalks adjacent to a university building are also included in the campus, which means that you cannot smoke on a sidewalk adjacent to a university building.

(1) Reason for implementation


Tohoku University confirms the safety of all students and staff in the event of major disasters.

The university decided to implement the Safety Confirmation System, which uses e-mail to efficiently and smoothly ascertain safety.

(2) Date implemented: October 2014~

(3) Eligibility: All students/staff

- (4) Description of system
 - Safety confirmation and emergency messages are sent from the university in the event of a disaster.
 - 2. Messages are sent to the e-mail address you registered.
 - 3. Follow the instructions in the message and contact the university.




(1) Registering e-mail addresses

This system contacts all users by email, so you need only register your e-mail address to receive messages from the university. You can register via the Student Affairs Information System (students) or Integrated Electronic Authentication System (staff).


*Your address for the Digital Campus Mail (DC Mail, implemented October 2014) will already be registered in the Safety Confirmation System

Students: How to register via the Student Affairs Information System

Safety confirmation messages will be sent to the addresses you enter in "E-mail address 1" and "Forwarding address."



(2) How to respond to e-mailed safety confirmation messages (example)



Click URL in the message's text.

Select responses for each item.

Click the Respond (回答) button.

Safety confirmation response is complete

Basic operations also same for mobile/smart phones.

You can respond through the official app

(3) Other

- 1. The sender's address will appear as tohoku-univ@anpi.tohoku.ac.jp Adjust your mail settings so you can receive messages from this domain.
- 2. If you receive no messages:
- -Is your in-box full? → Free some space in your in-box.
- -Is the message still on the mail server? → Run "Check for new messages" etc. on your mail client.
- -Do you have a mail filter? → Add the domain to your filter's whitelist.

(4) How to register via the official app



Download and install the free Emergency Call (エマージェンシーコール) app from the Apple App or Google Play Store. When configuring the connection settings, enter your Tohoku University ID and password to receive notifications from the app. (If you change your Integrated Electronic Authentication System password, please change the password in the app as well.)

1. On the initial configuration screen, enter the below links, shown in blue, for URL (1) and URL (2).

- 2. Enter your Tohoku University ID and password, then tap the "Register" button.
- * We recommend turning on "Save user ID and password."
- (3) The notification history screen will be displayed. This concludes initial setup.

(If you have no notification history, the screen will be blank.)



*The format of notifications may differ depending on your device and settings.

Tap the received notification, or tap the app icon to start it, and enter your responses.

The drill for the Safety Confirmation System

The drill for Tohoku University Safety Confirmation System will be held twice a year (in early summer and in autumn). As you will receive an email from the system at noon, please answer whether you are safe or not, as a reply to the email.

- If you do a human subject research in the field of psychology, physiology, medical science, pharmacy, human genome science, etc., you need to submit a designated application to the committee, at least about one month before the start of your research.
